COPPER FOREST set the pace and opened up, led to the stretch then was caught late. RELVADO showed no speed, angled out then closed willingly. FALLING KNIFE was void of speed, angled out then made a mild rally. TOCCET ROCKET was void of speed, circled the field and passed tiring rivals. SAARBRIGHT showed no speed and made no rally. RED MESA chased the pace, contended to the stretch and tired. AGRA raced in the second flight, contended to the stretch then tired. ARCH'S ARROW raced in the middle of the pack, had a rail trip then made no rally.
