Footnotes

LOVE THIS KITTEN bobbled a bit at the break, quickly recovered, then was urged to secure the lead from between foes racing to the backstretch, dictated the pace in hand on a clear margin along the inside racing into the far turn, held sway into upper stretch and just lasted to hold MULATA safe under firm right handed encouragement. The latter, unhurried tracking just off the second flight along the inside racing to the backstretch, dropped back into last nearing the far turn, shifted out in upper stretch while finding her best stride near the furlong marker and steadily closed the gap in the closing stages while angling inside the winner in the final sixteenth. ZIPPING AWAY, reserved just outside the pacesetter racing to the backstretch, prompted that foe racing into upper stretch but couldn't gain terms with that foe while losing second in late stages. DONTBETELLINME tracked off the second flight outside a rival in the opening half, shifted out to challenge three wide racing through the far turn, but flattened out in upper stretch. BASILIO'S THUNDER, held up inside foes tracking just off the pacesetter racing to the far turn, steadily faded from contention in the drive. THE BEST OPTION was settled in hand racing well off the inside to the backstretch and never mounted a serious challenge.
