**Footnotes**

ACE RICH was hustled to the lead along the inside racing to the first turn, dictated the pace on a clear margin just off the inside racing to the far turn and just maintained his advantage to the end under firm right handed encouragement. JILLY FROM PHILLY, reserved in the last flight while being guided to the rail racing into the first turn, made a steady advance to contention inside foes racing through the far turn into upper stretch, then moved to close the gap inside the winner late while always second best. PROSPECT KNIGHT, caught five wide racing into the first turn while being prompted to secure a contending position, continued with a steady advance three deep between foes to gain striking distance nearing midstretch and continued willingly in that path to the end while just outkicked by the top pair. TURN N' FIRE, forwardly placed three deep tracking just off the first flight racing to the far turn, was fanned four wide racing into upper stretch and continued evenly in late stages. PRIME SPEED, caught four wide between foes in the second flight racing to the backstretch, continued in that path racing into the far turn while making a brief bid but lacked the needed closing response. VOUCH FOR VICTORY was prompted to secure terms with the pacesetter racing into the backstretch, stalked that foe for a half, made a brief bid racing through the far turn and gave way nearing midstretch when proving no match. GOOD CHEMISTRY, pulling a bit along the inside tracking the leaders in second flight in the opening half, steadily retreated nearing upper stretch. BALLYJAMESDUFF was settled outside foes racing to the backstretch and never gained striking distance. FLATTERMEJIM, held up off the second flight between foes in the opening stages, dropped out of contention early.
