Footnotes

UZZIAH, bumped from both sides, then pinched back at the start, settled into stride along the inside racing to the backstretch, shifted out four wide nearing the far turn commencing his advance, continued in that path racing to upper stretch while moving to wrest command and made the balance of the pace under firm right handed prompting. WOLFCAMP, urged to contend near the pace in the opening stages, was eased off the pace avoiding close quarters entering the first turn to track the leaders from just out of striking distance in the opening half, shifted out to split foes leaving the far turn challenging for command, couldn't match terms with the winner but proved best of the others. BOMBINO, urged between foes to dispute the pace in the opening sixteenth, ceded the lead to several foes racing through the first turn to track just off those foes into the backstretch, made steady progress to challenge inside the leaders after a half, disputed the issue inside foes through the second bend but couldn't match the top pair in the final quarter. MR. CONDUCTOR angled to the inside early to track the pace from well out of striking distance between foes, shifted to the rail on the backstretch while making steady progress to gain striking distance racing into the far turn but lacked the needed final response. EN RAPPORT, bumped by STRONG LUCK, then forced into UZZIAH's path at the start, settled off foes collecting his stride racing to the backstretch and never gained contention. STRONG LUCK veered outwards at the break bumping EN RAPPORT and impeding several foes, was righted, then hustled to join the pace three deep between foes racing into the first turn, secured a

narrow advantage entering the backstretch, drifted well wide racing through the backstretch while losing his advantage, briefly contested the issue between foes racing into the second bend but quickly gave way. SHINE THE ROCKET, urged to contend inside foes from the break, was steadied out of tight quarters entering the first turn, settled along the inside and never regained contention. OH MY TODD broke inwards bumping UZZIAH, then stumbled after clipping heels in traffic just after the start, was rushed to join the pace four wide racing into the first turn, was carried out by STRONG LUCK midway through the backstretch, shifted nearer to the inside approaching the second bend but steadily faded from contention.
