### Footnotes

RIVALRY, in close attendance to the pace three deep while under rating racing to the backstretch, was prompted to force the issue outside the pacesetter midway through the far turn, couldn't gain even terms with the leader despite some pressure racing into upper stretch, but continued with a steady late response to wrest command then edge forward under firm encouragement in the final sixteenth. WEALTH MANAGEMENT tracked just off the first flight a bit off inside inside a rival racing to the backstretch, swung out four wide racing into upper stretch while being roused to advance and continued with a steady bid to prevail for place honors on the wire. KING FEST was urged to dictate the pace a bit off the inside racing to the backstretch, continued on his own courage through the far turn, held sway past midstretch under pressure but failed to sustain his momentum. HOLY UNO, in touch with the pacesetter between foes in the opening stages, emptied out after a half. LEGAL DEED tracked off the first flight outside a rival racing to the backstretch but dropped out of contention early.
