AL MUDEER broke readily to gain the advantage along the inside racing to the first turn, dictated the pace on a comfortable margin, steadily increased his advantage while shifting well off the rail on the second bend, drifted back to the inside under pressure racing through the stretch but maintained a safe margin to the end under right handed prompting. HEAD OF STATE settled out of striking distance off the inside racing to the backstretch, angled to the inside entering the far turn commencing a steady advance, switched outside the leader entering upper stretch while moving to challenge that foe but couldn't close the gap until the final sixteenth. REGAL QUEST tracked just off the second flight under light rating racing to the backstretch, steadily moved to contention while shifting out four wide on the far turn, was roused to challenge in that path entering upper stretch but finished evenly in late stages. BARANIT settled into stride near the inside in the opening half, saved ground to upper stretch but made an effort to improve position in late stages. JR HILLS was settled outside foes in the opening stages, shifted to the inside nearing upper stretch and passed some tiring rivals. GOHOMEBAY was urged to gain a contending position inside a rival in the second flight, was urged to challenge nearing the far turn but emptied out nearing upper stretch. KELPIE tracked the pacesetter three deep in the second flight in the opening half, then steadily retreated from contention between foes on the far turn.
