Footnotes

RADIANT DAY, off slowly, settled into stride tracking well off the second flight in the opening stages, readily advanced to contention splitting foes three deep in upper stretch, made some light contact with I'M OLD SCHOOL while challenging for command near the furlong marker and drew clear late under strong handling despite the loss of his rider's whip. PLUNDER settled well back in early stages while angling inside, saved ground to upper stretch, then angled out five wide in the furlong ground while continuing with interest to prevail for place honors. VALIANT CITY shifted off the inside early while under some prompting pursuing the leaders, moved to striking distance four deep racing into upper stretch while being urged to challenge and was just outkicked by the top pair. VBREEZE broke outwards bumping SHOWBIZ IS NY BIZ, was quickly righted, then urged to gain a forward placing, shifted out three deep nearing upper stretch while being urged to challenge, struck the front midstretch but failed to sustain that momentum. TWO LIONS was rated outside foes off the second flight in early stages, was fanned five wide nearing the lane while being caught between racing into upper stretch, gained some position late but made no real impression. IOLANDA'S PERFECT tracked the pace inside foes in the second flight, saved ground to upper stretch while being urged to advance but had no late response. PRINCE WHO was hustled to the lead while angling sharply to the rail, dueled for command along the inside to upper stretch and gave way. SHOWBIZ IS MY BIZ, bumped, then forced out at the start, offered no rally. ROAD TRIPPN settled outside foes in early stages, was fanned six wide racing into the lane and steadily faded. MORENO'S MINE tracked the pace between foes in second flight early, drifted out racing through the turn carrying out several rivals and soon gave way. I'M OLD SCHOOL, urged along chasing the pacesetter from the outset, lodged a brief bid between foes, came up empty in upper stretch, was brushed, then was steadied out of tight quarters leaving the furlong marker. FOLLOWING THE RACE THE

STEWARDS CONDUCTED AN INQUIRY INTO THE STRETCH RUN BUT NO ACTION WAS TAKEN.
