TOO MANY SINS raced in the second flight, angled out in the turn and made a bid, couldn't get the winner but closed the gap late wide. OK JOE pressed the pace between horses but failed to sustain her bid. CARSON CITY DUDE was slow early and had some late run. LET IT ROCK was far back on the backstretch and improved position. COMMANDO CHANT stalked the pace inside and gave way grudgingly. MOGUMBO CAT was through early and failed to menace. ROYAL MR. G contended early while wide then dropped back.
