Footnotes

NORTHERN SWALLOW, reserved in hand racing off the inside in the opening half, continued in hand while gradually moving to striking distance four deep on the far turn, angled seven wide in upper stretch and was roused to wrest command and edge forward in the final stages. **BELLERIVE**, bumped, then forced in at the start, was reserved outside a rival in the last flight racing to the far turn, angled out six deep racing into upper stretch and secured the place in late stages. **VEILED FROST** tracked off the second flight unhurried in the opening half, made a steady advance to striking position while shifting out four wide after six furlongs, bid for command nearing midstretch but was outkicked by the top pair. **TOO DIVINE** was guided to the inside soon after the start, saved ground to upper stretch, then swung outside foes to make some mild progress four deep. **SUSIE LARK** broke inwards bumping **BELLERIVE** was righted while working her way to the inside early tracking off the second flight, shifted out on the far turn to bid three deep between foes in upper stretch but proved empty in the last furlong. **VIA DI ROMA** settled along the rail in the opening half, shifted out nearing the far turn to split foes racing into upper stretch but lacked any further response. **LA COLORADA**, urged to secure a forward placing, drifted wide racing through the turn, was righted entering the

backstretch to gain terms with the pacesetter, forced the issue outside that foe into the far turn and gave way in upper stretch. STORMYS PROCLIVITY was urged to the fore along the inside, dueled for command into the far turn and emptied out nearing midstretch. BE DARING, forwardly placed outside a rival on the pace, relinquished position to a rival to stalk just off the leaders along the inside racing through the backstretch but came up empty when called upon to advance. LONG STORY SHORT tracked the leaders in second flight while angling to the inside entering the backstretch, moved to challenge along the rail in upper stretch but steadily faded when failing to produce a closing bid.
