Footnotes

KNIGHT AFTER NIGHT, urged to secure the lead while angling to the inside racing to the first turn, dictated the pace on a narrow margin racing to the far turn, was roused clear entering upper stretch and held sway to the end under firm encouragement. GREYTAP, held up out of close quarters racing into the first turn, tracked off the second flight four wide racing into the backstretch, made a steady advance to striking distance in that path racing into the far turn, couldn't match terms with the winner but proved best of the others. GRANDPA GIBBY, held up along the inside racing just off the pacesetter in the opening half, came through inside that foe racing into upper stretch to challenge but couldn't gain terms with that rival then was outfinished for second. AFLEET PADDY settled along the inside off the second flight racing to the far turn, angled four wide racing into upper stretch and continued to improve his placing. FAPTITUDE tracked the pace between foes in the second flight, made a brief, three wide bid between foes racing into the far turn but steadily faded racing into upper stretch. DANCE FOR PACO, reserved off the second flight between foes in the opening stages, never gained contention. AWESOMO, caught wide racing into the first turn, angled inwards on the backstretch to track just outside the pacesetter, briefly pressed the issue between foes racing into the far turn but gave way abruptly nearing upper stretch.
