Footnotes

OUTLAW ZEN was settled in hand along the inside dropping out of striking distance in the opening stages, shifted out five wide entering upper stretch while being roused to advance and produced a sustained rally to wrest command in time under firm left handed encouragement. TORO GRANDE was urged to the lead outside a rival racing into the first turn, shook clear into upper stretch but proved no match for the winner. UNCLE JEEP tracked off the second flight outside foes racing into the bend, shifted out four wide racing into upper stretch and made some mild progress to gain a share. CART'S GLITTER tracked just off the pacesetter three wide in the opening stages, moved to challenge in that path nearing upper stretch but had no final kick. ENEMY FIRE, caught five wide early, never gained contention. VAN DEMON was urged to dispute the pace along the inside racing into the bend and emptied out entering upper stretch.
