Footnotes

SLAMMIN EASY moved to the fore along the inside in the opening stages, dictated the pace on a clear margin into the turn and steadily extended the advantage to the end under pressure. ON THE RUN settled outside foes in the opening stages, angled six wide in upper stretch and prevailed for place honors. BUTTERCUPS BABY tracked off the second flight in the opening stages, was fanned seven wide racing through the stretch but made an effort to improve position. GIMME A DOUBLE tracked off the second flight in the opening stages and continued evenly four wide between foes racing into the stretch. OLD LOW DOWN tracked the leaders three deep in the second flight, made a brief bid in that path on the turn and emptied out racing into the stretch. R. CAMPFIRE tracked the pacesetter between foes in second flight and steadily faded racing into the stretch. GIBBY'S TORNADO was settled outside foes in early stages and never gained contention. COSTLY KING was a brief factor inside foes in the second flight but was through after a half. PACKLEN'S BID dropped out early.
