Footnotes

STREET SPICE, prominent between foes in the opening stages attending the pace, shifted to the rail nearing the half mile marker while maintaining his position, pressed the issue inside foes racing into upper stretch while going a bit greenly, then edged forward in the closing stages under firm right handed encouragement. GREAT GHOST broke inwards bumping J EVANS, was righted to track just off the first flight under rating into the backstretch, steadily advanced to challenge three deep racing into upper stretch, couldn't match the winner late but narrowly prevailed for place honors. BELLS BIG BERNIE joined the pace three deep racing into the first turn, continued to dispute the issue outside the eventual winner racing to the far turn, pressed the issue between foes into upper stretch but was outkicked by the top pair in the final stages. FINDING CANDY angled inwards early to track the leaders from just out of striking distance, continued between foes into the second bend, then made steady progress while shifting out four deep nearing midstretch to close the gap in late stages. WACKY INDIAN, forwardly placed along the rail in the opening stages, was eased off the pace on the backstretch to track the leaders into the second bend but had no closing bid. SHUE VIEW settled into stride near the inside racing to the backstretch, swung out five wide racing into upper stretch to gain some position but made no real impression. KEY THE CODE settled between foes in the opening stages, shifted out four wide racing into the stretch but never gained contention. J EVANS, bobbed, then was bumped at the start, settled three deep racing to the backstretch and never seriously menaced.
