SIGNSEALNDELIVER tracked the leaders unhurried from out of striking distance four deep in the second flight in the opening quarter, made steady progress in that path racing through the turn, was urged to challenge nearing midstretch, then gained command and kicked clear in time under brisk left handed pressure. NAGYS PIGGY BANK was urged to dispute the pace outside a rival from the break, forced the issue into upper stretch, resisted the winner when challenged by that foe to late stages but came up second best. SACRED GIFT tracked off the second flight outside foes in the opening stages, angled out five wide racing into upper stretch and continued with a mild bid to gain a share. RIVER BEAR worked his way to the rail in the opening stages to track behind foes in the second flight, saved ground to upper stretch and continued evenly along the rail to late stages. ROARIN MISSILE was urged to the lead along the rail from the break, dueled for command into upper stretch and gave way nearing the sixteenth marker. FOUR LEFT FEET broke slowly, was settled between foes in the last flight racing to the turn, swung out six wide racing into the stretch to gain some position but made no real impression. ST. MAXIMUS GATO tracked the leaders three deep between foes in second flight from just out of striking distance in the opening quarter, lodged a brief bid between foes nearing upper stretch but quickly flattened out. CATFEINATED tracked the pace three deep behind the second flight racing into the bend and steadily faded racing into the stretch. BLUE CANOE was settled outside foes early and never mounted a serious challenge. BIG LOOIE was a brief factor inside foes in the second flight racing through the backstretch but retreated from contention early. HOODWINKED showed little.
