SILVER ROCKET MAN was rated off the second flight along the inside early, steadily advanced along the inside on the far turn, came through close quarters splitting foes just off the inside entering upper stretch exchanging some contact with BETTER THAN FINE, was roused clear midstretch and extended the advantage under pressure. TIME FOR ALEX, reserved out of striking distance off the inside in the opening half, angled six wide racing through upper stretch and produced a steady late bid to prevail for second. TIZ HAPPENING, urged to the lead along the inside from the break, dueled for command into the far turn and gave way racing through upper stretch. WHAT BUNKER, caught in tight quarters near the inside racing into the first turn, was rated just off the first flight to the far turn, shifted out to bid three deep between foes nearing upper stretch, then flattened out in the drive. SUMMER IN MONTANA tracked the leaders outside foes in the second flight, moved to challenge four wide racing through the far turn but emptied out nearing midstretch. BETTER THAN FINE was hustled between foes while advancing in tight quarters to gain terms with a rival on the pace on the first turn, pressed the issue outside that foe to the second bend, weakened between foes racing into upper stretch, was bumped by the winner entering the lane and quickly came up empty. DITTYSUNBRIDLEDBOY never seriously menaced.
