RUSSIAN DANCER, held up along the inside stalking just off the first flight in the opening half, came through along the rail entering the far turn while making steady progress to challenge inside the first flight, disputed the issue to upper stretch and edged clear late under firm encouragement. **EVERT** was prompted to maintain striking distance racing three deep to the backstretch, pressed the issue outside a rival, then three deep racing through the far turn to upper stretch, continued willingly to the end but couldn't match the winner late. **CHEROBEN**, caught four wide racing through the first turn, was rated out of striking distance to the second bend, shifted out to bid four wide between foes racing into upper stretch but lacked the needed final kick while continuing well enough to earn a share. **FABULOUS UNION** was urged to the lead along the inside racing into the first turn, dictated the pace on a narrow margin a bit off the rail to the second bend, dueled for command between into upper stretch and gave way. **M J SEEKER**, held up off the first flight between foes racing to the far turn, continued evenly into the stretch. **MEDALQUEST**, a bit rank under restraint early, lodged a brief, four wide bid on the far turn but soon gave way.
