Footnotes

CARNACKS CHOICE secured a forward placing stalking just outside the pacesetter in hand racing to the bend, moved to even terms with that foe in upper stretch, wrested command leaving the furlong marker and edged clear late under firm right handed encouragement. FLAMING GLORY broke readily, dictated the tempo a bit off the inside racing into the turn, continued in that path to upper stretch, briefly resisted the winner nearing midstretch but proved only second best. KEYSTONE KID tracked the pace unhurried between foes just off the inside, lost some position on the turn, but responded to pressure to split rivals and improve his position in the final furlong. BILL OF BILLS tracked just off the leaders three deep between foes racing to the bend and continued evenly in that path to late stages. DEMIGOD tracked the pace in second flight along the rail, saved ground to upper stretch but lacked the needed closing response. GATO'S PIRATE tracked the pace unhurried as part of the second flight racing four wide into the turn, continued in that path to upper stretch and weakened in the last furlong.
