Footnotes

PRAIRIE FEVER shied from a rival at the start momentarily shifting into the path of AWESOME TRUTH, disputed the pace inside foes racing several paths off the rail, gained a narrow advantage in upper stretch and held safe the challenge of BAG TOSSER under steady handling. The latter bobbled just after the start, tracked the pace unhurried between foes racing to the bend, angled out four deep in upper stretch to challenge, drew on terms with the winner late but was always second best. UPTOWN BABE settled between foes in the opening stages, angled six wide racing into upper stretch and produced her best stride late to close the gap on the top pair. CORNER GIRL tracked the pace between foes in the second flight, angled to the inside leaving the turn while lodging a brief bid but quickly flattened out. AWESOME TRUTH, a bit unruly before the start, was carried inwards by the eventual winner at the break, gathered momentum nearing upper stretch, split foes three deep racing through the stretch and made some belated progress. DAMA DAMA joined the pace outside a rival in the opening stages, pressed that foe into upper stretch and gave way. STIVERS SUPRISE ducked outwards at the start, was righted to track the pace along the inside but never seriously menaced. TOP PAIR settled outside foes in the opening stages and never gained contention. ARE YOU DANCING stalked just off the first flight three deep racing into the bend and emptied out after a half. HEY JERRY angled to the inside early to track just off the leaders but steadily faded nearing upper stretch.
