LAGUNA AMIGA tracked the leaders unhurried a bit off the inside from just out of striking distance in the opening stages, made steady progress to gain

position between foes in the second flight entering the turn, briefly awaited an opening after a half, shifted inside foes to challenge along the rail in upper stretch and wrested command from the pacesetter in the final stages to narrowly prevail under steady handling. MON JOLENE was urged to the fore outside a rival from the outset, moved clear of that foe entering the turn to set the pace into upper stretch a bit off the inside, resisted challenges from both sides to late stages but proved only second best. OIL MONEY'S DREAM, forwardly placed four wide in the opening quarter, tracked the pacesetter unhurried racing to the turn, made a steady, three wide advance to challenge midway through the bend, closed the gap on the pacesetter near midstretch, couldn't match terms with the winner but finished on even terms with a rival to share place honors. QUEENLASEFA, held up racing in close quarters just after the start, made steady progress after a half to gain striking distance while shifting off the inside, split foes four wide near midstretch and continued willingly to close the gap to the end. WAY DOWN SOUTH, reserved between foes in the opening stages, shifted out in upper stretch to split foes five wide while making some progress late and improved her position to the end. THAT'S A STORY, on terms with the pacesetter in the opening stages, relinquished the lead to that foe to stalk the pace along the inside racing into the turn but steadily faded nearing upper stretch. ILY angled to the inside early while setting well off the pace, shifted out six wide racing into the stretch gaining some position but never seriously menaced. NINA NINA tracked the leaders five wide racing to the bend, made a brief bid in that path on the turn but emptied out after a half. UNCONDITIONAL tracked off the second flight four wide racing to the bend, was fanned six wide entering upper stretch but lacked the needed rally. SEATTLE PSALM, forwardly placed three deep between foes in the opening stages, advanced on the pacesetter to bid between rivals racing through the turn, but failed to sustain that effort and gave way leaving the furlong marker. SUPERFINE TIME never seriously menaced. MUDDY GATOR tracked the leaders along the rail racing to the bend and steadily faded from contention. DUE TO A TELETIMER MALFUNCTION, NO ELECTRONICALLY TIMED SPLITS WERE AVAILABLE AND THE RACE WAS HAND TIMED BY EQUIBASE.
