Footnotes

MASTMAN sped to the fore along the inside racing to the first turn, dictated the pace in hand on a narrow margin into the second bend, shook clear when prompted racing into upper stretch and maintained his advantage to the end under firm handling. DAD ARE WE HERE, held up three deep between foes off the second flight racing to the backstretch, was urged to advance while angling out five wide between foes leaving the far turn and produced a solid late response to close the gap on the winner. FUN ON THE BAYOU broke a step slowly, settled outside a rival for a half, swung six wide while being urged to advance nearing upper stretch and continued to make mild progress in that path to the end. DARRELL SAYS angled inwards to track just off the pacesetter inside foes in the second flight racing into the far turn but lacked a closing response. BIG BAD MIKE tracked the pace four wide off the second flight racing to the backstretch, made a brief advance to challenge four wide between foes nearing upper stretch but quickly flattened out. PRAIRIE RIDGE tracked off the second flight a bit off the inside in the opening half but couldn't produce the needed closing bid. SAHM LIKE IT HOT raced four wide between foes in the second flight in the opening stages, continued outside a rival in the second flight on the backstretch, made a brief, three wide bid racing through the far turn but quickly emptied out. SOUTHLAND JAZZ, caught five wide while gaining terms with the first flight racing into the first turn, continued to pull his way along while a bit rank, pressed the pacesetter into the second bend and soon emptied out. IN ALL DIRECTIONS tracked the pace three deep between foes in the second flight but steadily retreated after a half. DOUG JUNIOR broke awkwardly and never seriously menaced.
