DREAMING BLUE was rated just off the first flight a bit off the inside racing to the backstretch, continued under patient handling while dropping into last on the backstretch, was urged to advance nearing upper stretch to split foes three deep and produced a steady late response to narrowly prevail in time under firm handling. HATTAASH, in touch with the leaders three deep between foes in the opening stages, was eased off the pace to track the leaders outside foes, continued with a steady bid entering the far turn to dispute the issue into upper stretch, gained the advantage between calls late and was just outfinished. PART'N PARCEL joined the pace four wide racing into the first turn, angled to the inside gaining the advantage after the opening quarter, duelled for command into upper stretch and was just outkicked. TABLE GAMES, held up along the inside racing in close quarters in the opening half, shifted out entering upper stretch and made an effort to improve position near the inside. LUV BANDIT, forwardly placed along the rail racing to the backstretch, tracked the leaders saving ground through the far turn and steadily faded into upper stretch. MYSTIC tracked the pace between foes in second flight, shifted out three deep on the far turn while being prompted to advance but had no closing bid. BALLYJAMESDUFF settled outside foes in the opening half, lodged a brief bid racing four wide into the far turn but quickly emptied out.
