BARREL RACER saved ground near the middle of the field and rallied for the place while no danger to the winner. JOURNEY FEVER was five wide on the first turn and rallied belatedly for a share. TENSA DEBUT pressed the pace from just outside and tired. TORNADO BAIT raced close up off the rail and tired. POETS AND ANGELS was four wide on the first turn and was through early.
