STRONG STAG gained the lead, held well into the stretch, dug in gamely but was worn down. TAZZ raced in striking position while four wide, continued four wide into the stretch and kept on. THE ALCOVA KID awkward at the start, was reserved, swung five wide into the stretch and managed no rally. STANLEY G. stalked the pace and weakened. NOLAN'S TERRITORY showed little.
