LUMPY'S ACE gained a position just off the pacesetter stalking that foe four deep as part of the second flight in the opening stages, steadily advanced to striking position in that path racing through the turn, moved to challenge nearing upper stretch, was carried out nearing midstretch by FIRST GUESS but edged clear of that foe in late stages under firm handling. The latter stalked just off the pacesetter near the inside early, moved to challenge between foes nearing upper stretch, drifted out resisting the winner's challenge racing through the stretch but came up second best. THIEF, bumped at the start then forced into the path of PORT HUDSON, was quickly righted to track the pace between foes off the second flight racing into the bend, angled out five wide

nearing upper stretch to challenge, couldn't match terms with the top pair and finished evenly late while earning a share. VICE LORD was settled off the inside from well out of striking distance early, split foes racing into upper stretch, then angled out four wide in late stages while making an effort to improve position. JOHNNIES BREEZE, close up three deep between foes between foes in the second flight, was urged to duel in that path racing through the turn and gave way nearing midstretch. PORT HUDSON, bumped at the start, worked his way to the inside racing to the bend, made some brief progress to gain position after a half but had no final bid. LUMPSINMYOATMEAL settled in last along the inside racing into the turn and passed only tiring rivals. ALABAMA CLAY sped to the lead while angling to the inside, dueled for command on the turn and gave way after a half. BEHR FACT tracked the pace five deep off the second flight in the opening stages but soon retreated from contention. BRAIN TEAZE tracked off the second flight four wide between foes in the opening quarter but dropped out of striking distance early. ONE TUFF STORM broke outwards bumping THIEF, was righted to chase the leaders along the inside but was spent early.
