PEYOTE PATTY secured a contending position just off the first flight in the opening stages, was rated while dropping off those foes racing into the backstretch, made steady progress to gain striking distance entering the far turn on her own courage, moved to wrest command in upper stretch when given her cue and drew clear while shifting to the inside under firm right handed encouragement. JITTERBUG BLUES, reserved from just out of striking distance three deep racing to the backstretch, gradually drew into contention outside foes on the far turn, angled four wide racing into upper and continued with a steady effort to narrowly prevail for place honors. SEANS SILVERDANCER, urged to dispute the lead inside a rival racing into the first turn, gained a narrow advantage on the backstretch, dictated the pace to the second bend, edged clear to a brief advantage midway through the far turn but couldn't fend off the winner's bid and lost second in late stages. AMERICA'S BLOSSOM settled out of striking distance along the inside in the opening half, shifted out racing into upper stretch and made an effort to improve her position. DUNDALK DUST, off last, settled outside a rival racing to the backstretch, angled five wide racing into upper stretch but made no impression on the leaders. CATALINA WAY went up to prompt the pace outside a rival racing into the first turn, disputed the issue to the second bend and gave way leaving the far turn.
