SPECIAL VICTORY, reserved in hand saving ground racing well out of striking distance to the backstretch, swung outside foes gathering momentum midway through the far turn, rallied five deep racing through the stretch and took over nearing the wire under firm handling. MOUNTAIN FELIX angled inwards gaining a forward placing, attended a rival's pace racing to the second bend, pressed that foe into upper stretch, couldn't contain the winner but continued well enough to save the place. PRIZED DANCER settled near the inside in the opening half, shifted off the inside nearing upper stretch, found her best stride nearing the furlong marker while angling six deep and was going well late. ABBEY'S WISH was urged to the fore while angling inside foes racing to the first turn, dictated the pace on a narrow margin to the second bend, dueled inside a rival into upper stretch and gave out in the final sixteenth. ANGEL COOKIE tracked the leaders outside foes in the second flight in the opening stages, advanced three deep to challenge after six furlongs but flattened out in upper stretch. MY BARBS tracked the pace between foes in the second flight racing to the far turn, then steadily retreated nearing upper stretch lane. SUPER LADYBUG settled off the inside early, made brief progress racing into the far turn but lacked the needed final response. G STREET BAND broke slowly and never gained contention. ARRESTED BY DUFFY tracked off the second flight to the far turn but couldn't produce a closing bid. SPRINGTIME ALIBI was a brief factor along the inside but was through after a half. LADY KNOWN AS LEW, forwardly placed between foes, racing to the backstretch, couldn't match the leaders on the second bend and gave way abruptly in upper stretch.
