Footnotes

DA GRIZZ held up out of close quarters at the start, raced under some reserve outside a rival into the backstretch, commenced a steady advance on the second bend, swung out five wide in upper stretch, then rallied sharply to the front to edge TEXAS HEDGE nearing the wire under firm handling. The latter reserved along the rail from just out of striking distance, saved ground on the second bend advancing to contention, split foes near the inside in upper stretch, gained a narrow advantage in late stages but couldn't fend off the winner. MOMENTARILY joined the pace three deep racing to the backstretch, pressed the issue in that path into the far turn, continued to dispute the issue between foes into upper stretch but yielded to the top pair late. LUCKY MERLOT tracked the leaders outside a rival from just out of striking distance early, advanced on the second bend to bid four wide between foes racing into upper stretch but had no final kick. MOLANDER was urged to gain terms with several rivals on the lead along the rail in the opening quarter, dueled for command racing into the far turn and gave way leaving the furlong marker. BOSCO RULES tracked just off the first flight in the opening half, bid three wide between foes racing into upper stretch and emptied out. LITTLEBROWNROAD shifted off the inside racing to the backstretch, advanced to contention racing four deep on the far turn but flattened out nearing upper stretch. FRANK'S TIME settled off the inside early, raced wide to upper stretch and lacked the needed rally. RIVERSIDE RASCAL settled along the inside early and never gained contention. MARKY P never seriously menaced. FORGIVE YOUR SINS dueled for command between foes into the backstretch and gave way abruptly midway through the second bend.
