Footnotes

LATIN JOURNEY shifted to the rail in early stages gaining a position just off the first flight, raced under firm rating tracking the leaders into the second bend, shifted out in upper stretch to split foes three deep, then responded to firm left handed encouragement to prevail nearing the wire. EASTERN PRECIPICE, forwardly placed from the break, stalked the pacesetter under reserve racing into the backstretch, took over from that foe entering upper stretch, resisted the winner's bid to late stages but proved only second best. SILVER CRUSH, reserved out of striking distance while caught four wide racing into the first turn, angled out five wide racing into upper stretch and produced a steady late response to close the gap and earn a share. ABUELA EMMA tracked the leaders three deep in the second flight racing to the backstretch, continued outside a rival into the second bend, was fanned four wide racing into upper stretch while moving to challenge but had no final kick. MARGO'S DELIGHT broke outwards bumping JELLY BUTTER, was settled off the second flight near the inside racing to the backstretch, shifted out in upper stretch and improved her position between foes to late stages. NIKALUK, held up three deep tracking off the second flight racing to the far turn, was fanned five wide racing into upper stretch but offered no rally. LADY OF RIVENDELL, reserved off the second flight

along the inside in the opening half, steadily faded from contention racing into the stretch. JELLY BUTTER, bumped at the start, settled in last in the opening half and never gained contention. TWO BAYME, reserved between foes from out of striking distance early, dropped out after a half. SUCCESSFUL BID moved to the fore along the inside racing to the backstretch, set the pace on a narrow margin into the far turn and gave way after six furlongs.
