Footnotes

PRINCE CHEVAL secured a position four deep between foes in the second flight tracking the leaders, made a steady advance from that position to advance on the leaders racing into upper stretch, steadily closed the gap on HE GONE leaving the furlong marker and prevailed under firm handling. The latter, urged to dispute the pace along the inside from the outset, turned back a challenger racing into upper stretch to gain a clear advantage but couldn't quite fend off the winner. CHATFIELDS CHAP settled off the inside in the opening stages, swung seven wide racing into upper stretch and made some belated progress to narrowly prevail for a share. LAKOTA WOLF tracked the leaders between foes in the second flight and continued willingly three deep between foes to the end to improve his placing. DE GREEN LIGHT tracked the leaders along the inside in second flight, saved ground to upper stretch and continued evenly to late stages. GEORGIE MY BOY broke inwards bumping CHAS THE MAN, was righted to press for command three deep between foes racing to the turn, pressed the issue to gain a narrow advantage after a half but failed to sustain his momentum in the last furlong. REPORT CARD angled inwards to briefly dispute the pace between foes racing into the turn but was through after a half. CAPTAIN MARVIN, held up avoiding close quarters soon after the start, never gained contention. PISTOL PERSUASION, a bit slow into stride, raced wide into the turn and never proved any factor. TWINE joined the pace four wide soon after the break, pressed the pace in that path racing into the turn and gave way in upper stretch. BOOGIE MAN JOE, going a bit erratically between foes tracking off the second flight racing to the turn, ducked out approaching the three furlong marker and quickly dropped out. CHAS THE MAN, bumped by GEORGIE MY BOY at the start, was caught five wide in the second flight racing into the turn and quickly retreated entering upper stretch.
