DUTCHIE pressed the pace just outside, took the lead on the final turn and held sway under urging. BUTTERCUP EXPRESS raced close up just outside, challenged in the stretch and was outfinished. DIRECT raced off the rail and gained a share while no match for the top two. BESO DEL SOL set the pace from the inside while pressed and tired. EXPEDITE IT was never a factor. OLD DIXIE HOME lacked speed, made a bid on the final turn and faltered. VIRTUE OHSO was four wide on the first turn and gave way after a half. PETITE ZINGER also gave way. SKY GIRL was five wide on the first and trailed throughout.
