PEARL EXPRESS chased the pace while four wide, hooked the eventual winner around the far turn, proved no match but kept on. COMELATELEAVEARLY reserved early, moved three wide into the stretch and lacked a rally. BEAT THE FREEZE settled well, moved five wide into the stretch and gave no response. MY SONNY BOY was always outrun. GOLD BLADE was forwardly placed and faded. IRON VOW saved ground to no avail. STANLEY G. stalked the pace and weakened. STOLEN GLORY was no factor.
