POPLAR HOUSE was guided to the inside early to track the pacesetter inside foes from just out of striking distance, steadily moved to terms with the leader while shifting outside that foe to challenge in tandem with a rival entering the far turn, continued with a steady response between foes to gain a narrow advantage near midstretch and just maintained the advantage to the end under strong handling. TIZ A SCHOLAR, reserved between foes from out of striking distance in the opening half, shifted out four deep on the far turn commencing his advance, was fanned six wide racing into the stretch but continued to make steady progress to the end to gain terms with the winner while prevailing for place honors. NO SONG N DANCE tracked off the second flight along the inside in the opening half, steadily drew into contention on the inside on the far turn, shifted out four wide in upper stretch to challenge the leaders but flattened out leaving the furlong marker. JUMP TO START tracked the pacesetter three deep in second flight under rating in the opening half, continued with a steady bid in tandem with the eventual winner racing through the far turn to upper stretch but was outkicked while racing in close quarters between foes to late stages. FRANK'S TIME tracked off the second flight between foes under light rating in the opening stages, was shuffled back in traffic while avoiding a tiring foe nearing the far turn, shifted to the inside on the far turn and continued evenly inside foes in late stages. GROOM, off a step slowly, tracked the pace outside foes off the second flight for a half, was urged to advance while being fanned five wide between foes racing into the stretch and continued evenly in that path through the final furlong. TSUNAMI KING caught four wide to the backstretch, never seriously menaced. A FLEETING MEMORY was urged to gain the lead along the rail racing into the first turn, set the pace on a diminishing margin into the second bend and emptied out nearing upper

stretch. CAUSE CAUSE CAUSE was urged to gain a forward placing tracking his entymate between foes in the second flight for a half and steadily retreated entering the far turn. SHOW YOUR FACE trailed.
