Footnotes

LADY JOBURG joined the pace outside a rival racing into the first turn, shook clear while angling nearer to the inside racing into the backstretch, maintained a clear margin through the second bend and held sway to the end under firm encouragement. HARD ROCK GIRL, urged to dispute the pace along the inside racing into the first turn, tracked the pacesetter inside foes racing into the second bend, was urged to challenge nearing upper stretch but was always only second best. LITTLE WHITE STAR tracked the pace outside foes in the second flight, shifted in on the backstretch to lodge a brief, three wide bid nearing the far turn, couldn't match terms with the winner and finished evenly in late stages. DUBAI MAGPIE shifted off the inside early gaining a position in the second flight, was shuffled a bit to race four wide midway through the backstretch, continued in that path into the far turn, drifted wide racing into upper stretch and steadily faded from contention. DARLAND was settled in last racing to the far turn and never gained contention. NOVENTA tracked off the second flight outside foes in the opening stages and dropped out after a half. TIGHTROPE DANCER was a brief factor tracking just off the second flight racing to the backstretch but emptied out early.
