CAN'T STOP RAVIN broke sharply to gain the advantage, disputed the pace outside a rival in the opening furlong, forged clear racing into the turn while remaining off the rail, continued in that path to upper stretch and withstood the late challenge of BATITO to prevail under firm handling. The latter broke slowly, commenced a steady advance along the rail racing into the turn, was urged to challenge inside the pacesetter nearing midstretch but came up second best. GARLAND'S SPIRIT was urged to terms with the pacesetter along the inside in the opening stages, dropped off that foe while switching off the inside to track the leader on the turn, switched out under pressure nearing the furlong marker momentarily impeding CUARTO CUATES but continued willingly outside the leaders to prevail for a share. DAKOTA'S COURT settled into stride dropping out of striking distance early, angled to the inside on the turn but continued with a steady late response to improve position inside foes in late stages. TRUEBILL settled in last off the inside racing to the turn, shifted out four wide racing into the stretch but continued with an effort to improve position between foes in that path in late stages. DANDYMAN tracked the leaders from just out of striking distance racing to the turn, angled out five wide racing into upper stretch but lacked the needed late response. CUARTO CUATES tracked just off the first flight a bit off the inside, moved to challenge three deep racing into upper stretch, was steadied, then forced to alter course avoiding GARLAND'S SPIRIT leaving the furlong marker but lacked the needed final response. FOLLOWING THE RACE THE TRAINER OF CUARTO CUATES LODGED A CLAIM OF FOUL AGAINST THE RIDER OF GARLAND'S SPIRIT WHILE THE STEWARDS CONDUCTED A CONCURRENT INQUIRY. FOLLOWING A REVIEW OF THE STRETCH RUN, THE STEWARDS DISQUALIFIED GARLAND'S SPIRIT FOR INTERFERENCE, PLACING HIM LAST.
