Footnotes

PICKLE SPRINGS broke readily, moved to the fore while angling nearer to the inside, dictated the pace on a comfortable margin racing into the turn, steadily drew clear nearing midstretch and was kept to pressure to maintain the advantage. ARGUE THE TOSS tracked the leaders between foes in the second flight, shifted out four deep nearing upper stretch while being urged to advance, couldn't menace the winner but proved best of the others. SPECIALAGENTNCHARG came through close quarters just after the start to gain a position outside foes in the second flight racing to the turn, was fanned five wide racing into the stretch but continued with a mild bid to earn a share. AULT STREET tracked off the second flight a bit off the inside in the opening stages, split foes racing into upper stretch and continued with interest to improve position. SONORI'S PRIDE tracked the leaders inside foes in the second flight, saved ground on the turn while going a bit erratically, was urged to challenge racing into upper stretch but lacked the needed final kick. BEAR MEDICINE broke slowly losing position to the leaders, saved ground throughout and continued evenly inside foes to gain some position in the stretch.

SILVER SUNRISE broke awkwardly, then was steadied out of tight quarters at the start, raced outside foes off the second flight to the turn, was fanned six wide racing into the stretch but made no real impression. MISS LIVINGSTON was a brief factor five deep in the second flight racing to the turn, continued in that path on the bend and steadily faded nearing upper stretch. DASH AWAY, steadied out of tight quarters then shuffled back just after the start, dropped well off the field and never menaced thereafter. WHITEYEDCOWGIRL broke slowly, dropped into last and never seriously menaced. CHESTNUT SOUP gained terms with a rival on the pace from the outset, prompted the leader racing into upper stretch and gave way abruptly.
