Footnotes

ZURI'S GIRL secured a stalking position just outside the pacesetter in the opening stages, attended that rival's pace to upper stretch, moved to wrest command nearing the furlong marker and went clear under firm encouragement. SPRINGTIME SPELL was urged to the lead while angling over racing to the turn, dictated the pace on a narrow margin a bit off the inside to upper stretch but couldn't match the winner in the last furlong. CART'S LINDA shifted outwards a bit while gaining a position outside foes in the second flight, bid four wide for command after a half but flattened out in upper stretch. MISS FONTANA tracked the leaders in second flight between foes racing to the turn and continued evenly into the stretch. SCHEFFLERA, forwardly placed along the inside in the opening stages, briefly pressed inside the pacesetter on the bend but steadily weakened leaving midstretch. RASPBERRY JAM shifted out while racing in some traffic after the start and never gained contention. JANE OF ARCADIA settled along the inside early and never mounted a serious challenge.
