Footnotes

WEED OF WILDFLOWER gained a position four wide in the second flight in the opening stages, advanced three deep on the bend to challenge for command in upper stretch, wrested command leaving the furlong marker and edged clear late under firm encouragement. SHARE THE JOY was urged to the fore inside foes, duelled for command into upper stretch, couldn't contain the winner but held well for the place. LISA'S TIGER settled inside foes from just out of striking distance early, swung out splitting foes nearing upper stretch to advance five wide racing through the lane and produced a solid late response to close the gap on the top pair. TAWDRY settled off the inside in the opening three furlongs, split foes nearing the furlong marker and made some belated progress. NAN'S LILLIE tracked the leaders in second flight inside foes racing to the bend, shifted out to bid between rivals nearing upper stretch but lacked the needed final kick. SIN BIN, reserved near the inside in the opening stages, made some belated progress between foes. CAMPO JOTI angled to the rail early to track behind the second flight, continued in that path to upper stretch but offered no closing bid. PEPPERMINT FUDGE, caught five wide between foes tracking off the second flight racing to the turn but never mounted a serious challenge. GLIDING THRU TIME tracked off the second flight six

deep in the opening quarter and steadily retreated from contention. CHAMPAGNE SHIMMY was a brief factor between foes but dropped out after a half. AUNDREYA, forwardly placed from the outset, attended a rival's pace racing well off the inside in the opening quarter, couldn't match the leaders after a half and gave way. TIFFANCO was never a factor.
