Footnotes

WONDER COUNTRY, never far back, stalked just off the pacesetter under some reserve racing to the backstretch, steadily drew on terms with that foe racing into upper stretch, wrested command leaving the furlong marker then edged forward in late stages under left handed pressure and steady handling. DIVA'S DIAMOND tracked off the second flight unhurried outside foes in the opening half, made steady progress four deep leaving the midway point of the far turn to gain terms with the second flight nearing midstretch, then found her best stride late to close the gap on the winner. JULIA'S BREEZE, reserved from just out of striking position while shifting outside foes racing to the backstretch, commenced a three wide advance racing through the far turn to gain terms with the first flight after six furlongs, couldn't maintain terms with the winner in late stages but continued willingly to the end to narrowly prevail for a share. LOVE THY NEIGHBOR tracked the pace unhurried off the second flight along the inside to the far turn, saved ground to upper stretch, shifted out to split foes just off the inside leaving midstretch and was just outfinished for a share. LION D N A broke readily, dictated the pace in hand along the inside to the far turn, briefly resisted the winner's challenge racing into upper stretch but yielded leaving the furlong marker. ABBY'S SLEW was guided to the inside early to track off the second flight, shifted out nearing the far turn while being urged to advance but offered no closing bid. MISSMOLLYBYGOLLY, a bit rank under reserve tracking just off the pacesetter along the inside racing to the backstretch, saved ground on the second bend and steadily faded racing through the stretch. LITTLE MARY E broke slowly, was held up out of tight quarters at the start and trailed throughout.
