MISS JULIA raced unhurried off the second flight along the inside in the opening stages, shifted out three wide entering the turn gathering momentum, moved to terms with the leaders on her own courage in that path nearing upper stretch, took command and drew away under firm encouragement. CHAPA RITA tracked the pacesetter outside a rival in the second flight, steadily moved to challenge the pacesetter in tandem with the eventual winner leaving the midway point of the turn, couldn't match that foe racing into upper stretch but proved best of the others. SLIGO ROSE was settled off the inside in the opening stages, then made steady progress three deep on the turn to upper stretch to improve position and gain a share. DUBAI MAGPIE swerved out at the start, was settled in last racing to the turn and passed tiring rivals into the stretch. URMYBABY was hustled to the lead along the inside soon after the break, set the pace on a clear margin for a half and gave way abruptly once headed by the winner. DUBAIDORA, urged to position inside a rival in the second flight in the opening stages, steadily faded nearing upper stretch. DUE CAUSE settled outside foes in early stages, angled to the inside entering the turn but offered no closing bid. CAUSE I'M LUCY tracked off the second flight in the opening quarter but dropped out of contention early.
