Footnotes

WINNINGCHEROKEE was rated between foes in the second flight racing to the backstretch, commenced a steady, three wide bid to challenge for command nearing upper stretch, gained a narrow advantage from between foes approaching the furlong marker and edged clear late under firm encouragement. CANADIAN WISH, caught four wide racing into the first turn while gaining a contending position, tracked just off the second flight racing to the far turn, moved to challenge the leader in that path racing into upper stretch but proved no match late. SAAR settled in last racing to the far turn, angled out nearing upper stretch and made some belated progress. HAMMERS BULLET tracked the pacesetter nearest the inside as part of the second flight, moved to press the issue along the rail entering the backstretch, edged forward racing into the far turn but failed to sustain that momentum. SAILING ALONG, in touch early, was eased off the pace while angling to the angling inside racing into the far turn but had no closing bid. KITTEN'S RULE was urged to the lead a bit off the inside racing to the backstretch, disputed the pace outside a rival into the second bend and emptied out nearing upper stretch.
