PLEASE SIGN IN stumbled at the start, took the lead inside on the backstretch, set the balance of the pace and battled gamely but lost the nod on the wire. LA PASCUA (SWI) saved ground then came up the rail with a late bid to gain a share. MS. DEEP POCKETS raced close up off the rail and weakened. FACCIA BELLA lacked speed and showed little. WADE FOR ME made a mild bid on the final turn and faltered. RUSH ST TYPE pressed the pace to the stretch and tired. PRAIRIE SPRING was through early.
