BRIDGET SAYS lacked speed, angled out, rallied in the stretch and drew off late. ROSEAL lacked speed, came out for the drive and gained the place but could not reach the winner. AFTERNOON DREAMS took up into the first turn, lacked speed, angled out for the drive and rallied belatedly. ONE OTHER THAN saved ground but lacked a serious rally. GHOSTLY GAL stalked the pace from just outside and tired. DOING IT OUR WAY improved her position in the drive. COMBAT SOLDIER set the pace on a clear lead from the inside and tired. VENTURE TO SAY was five wide on the first turn, lacked speed and was never a factor. ORO CALIENTE was fractious in the gate, raced near the middle of the field and gave way. POETIC HONOR made a bid on the final turn and faltered. MISS CONNIE SUE raced close up inside and tired. GOLD SPOT raced close up off the rail and gave way.
