Footnotes

HISTORIAN stumbled at the start, was allowed to collect his stride racing just out of striking distance racing to the backstretch, split foes three wide in the second flight to advance on the leaders entering the far turn, drew on terms with the leaders nearing midstretch and went clear in the final furlong under firm urging. TO THE MOON settled near the inside in the opening half, gathered momentum midway through the second bend, split foes three wide racing into upper stretch and produced his best stride in the final furlong to secure the place nearing the wire. OSAGE IRON, forwardly placed from the break, stalked the pacesetter under rating racing into the far turn, moved to challenge that foe on the second bend, pressed between foes into upper stretch and weakened when failing to match the winner late. CORNEL NOBLE sped to the lead along the rail, set the pace racing into the far turn, briefly resisted the winner's challenge racing into upper stretch but weakened late. ALLOW tracked the pace off the inside from out of striking distance, was caught five wide racing into the far turn and lacked the needed closing response. HE'S SULTRY settled outside a rival in the opening half and never gained striking distance. RULEROUS was urged to gain a position in the second flight while caught three and four deep racing to the backstretch, continued in the four path entering the far turn while lodging a brief bid but failed to sustain that effort through the final quarter. GRATAN STREET tracked just off the leaders outside a rival in the second flight racing to the far turn, came up empty on the second bend and steadily retreated nearing upper stretch. BRISTOL BOY, held up along the inside tracking the leaders in second flight in the opening half, saved ground to upper stretch but steadily faded from contention.
