### Footnotes

KEPI, reserved in hand from just out of striking distance racing three deep into the first turn, continued under patient handling leading the second flight into the second bend, swung out four wide entering upper stretch and responded to firm handling to wrest command and kick clear in late stages. FIVE STAR LINE was urged to secure the lead in the opening stages, dictated the pace on a narrow margin along the inside to the far turn, resisted several challengers racing into upper stretch but couldn't fend off the winner's bid. LET IT RAIN, reserved along the rail in the opening half racing as part of the second flight, saved ground to upper stretch and continued well enough inside foes to prevail for a share. POINT YOUR FINGER broke readily, was held up stalking just off the pacesetter along the inside racing to the backstretch, saved ground on the second bend, shifted out entering upper stretch to briefly challenge for command but lacked the needed final response. MYA FACCIA BELLA, reserved outside foes in the opening stages, continued four deep in the second flight on the backstretch, shifted back into that path while being urged to advance racing into upper stretch but continued evenly to late stages. GOLDWAY, forwardly placed stalking just off the pacesetter in the opening half, moved to press the leader racing through the far turn but emptied out abruptly in upper stretch. ART OF DECEPTION, reserved out of close quarters while shifting to the inside early, was a bit rank under restraint racing into the first turn and never gained contention. BELLERIVE settled outside foes in the opening stages, gained some position while racing five wide into upper stretch but proved no real threat. GOLDEN TEARDROP tracked off the second flight between foes in the opening stages under some reserve but dropped out of contention early.
