TOP PAIR was rated saving ground off the second flight in the opening half, continued in that fashion to upper stretch while gradually drawing into striking distance, shifted out nearing the furlong marker to split foes just off the inside challenging for command and responded to strong handling to edge clear late. AVENUE SISTER, held up off the first flight from just out of striking distance along the rail racing to the backstretch, steadily drew into contention nearing upper stretch, split foes just off the inside entering upper stretch challenging for command, gained a narrow advantage approaching the furlong marker but proved no match for the winner in the final sixteenth. DOILLOOKFATNTHESE, urged to secure the lead from between foes in the opening furlong, angled to the rail dictating the pace on a narrow margin to the far turn, edged forward between calls racing into upper stretch but yielded to the top pair leaving the furlong marker. MOURETTE, reserved three deep well off the second flight racing to the backstretch, continued with a steady advance on the far turn, swung four wide racing into upper stretch while being urged to gain striking distance but flattened out leaving the furlong marker. EMBERS GLOWING was settled in last racing to the backstretch, shifted outside foes on the far turn, angled five wide racing into upper stretch gaining some position but finished evenly in late stages. ROMAN INVADER, reserved while making her way to the inside in early stages, shifted out entering upper stretch but had no closing bid. HOIST THE COLORS tracked off the first flight outside a rival under some reserve in the opening half, lodged a brief, three wide bid on the far turn but came up empty in the drive. CAVE CREEKER tracked the pace outside a rival off the second flight in the opening half, was urged to advance between foes but quickly came up empty leaving the far turn. DELIGHTFUL DAISY, urged to secure terms with a rival on the pace in the opening stages, prompted that

foe racing into the far turn and gave way abruptly in upper stretch.
