Footnotes

TWO LEFT SHOES was prompted to secure a forward placing while shifting outside a rival in the opening stages, continued with a steady bid to challenge for command racing into upper stretch, gained the advantage nearing the furlong marker and shook clear late under firm right handed prompting. DEVILS TOWER tracked the pace between foes in the second flight, shifted out four wide racing into the stretch while being urged to advance and narrowly prevailed for place honors while failing to gain terms with the winner. PENNY PINCHIN PAT tracked the leaders inside foes in the second flight racing into the turn, shifted out in upper stretch to bid between foes and continued with interest while just missing for second. LITTLE KICK was urged to gain the lead outside a rival in the opening furlong, angled to the inside after securing the advantage, dictated the tempo along the rail through the bend, dueled for command into upper stretch and weakened in late stages. SPORTING GENT tracked the pace outside foes in the second flight, was fanned five wide racing into upper stretch and faded in the last furlong. GAELIC BREEZE settled in last while angling to the rail racing into the turn and never gained contention.
