Footnotes

KITTEN'S KITTEN was settled outside foes well off the second flight in the opening half, steadily gathered momentum outside foes on the turn, swung out five wide in upper stretch and produced a sustained rally to gain command under pressure. TRIBECKY broke outwards bumping MS. CAUTION, was collected, then urged to the lead along the inside, dictated the pace on a clear margin while shifting off the inside into upper stretch, couldn't contain the winner's bid but turned back a rival to prevail for second. SHARP TRIP tracked the pace outside foes in the second flight, made steady progress to challenge three deep nearing midstretch but flattened out late. VERY SPEIGHTSTOWN tracked the leader inside a rival in the second flight, steadily moved to contention nearing upper stretch while bidding inside the pacesetter but weakened leaving the furlong marker. I SEE MAMBO tracked off the second flight outside foes and continued evenly four wide racing into the stretch. OUR GIRL MAGIC tracked off the second flight between foes racing to the turn and offered no closing bid. MS. CAUTION, forced out at the start, never regained contention. MISS PALATINE was a brief factor three deep between foes in the opening stages and steadily retreated after a half.
