PEACH BOTTOM, pulling a bit in the opening stages, was reserved just off the first flight racing three deep to the bend, advanced to challenge in that path after a half, continued to dispute the issue outside a rival to midstretch and edged clear late under steady prompting. TESSIES TILBURY angled to the rail while securing the lead in the opening stages, set the pace under light rating racing into the bend, resisted the winner's challenge past midstretch but proved only second best. SATIN SWEEP, reserved off the inside in the opening stages, angled four wide on the bend while making steady progress and continued continued willingly in that path to gain a share while no match for the top pair. KEL'S DREAMER angled inwards a bit gaining terms with a rival on the pace, attended that foe's tempo under some reserve, pressed the issue between foes racing into upper stretch but weakened in the final furlong when failing to match the winner. OUR GIRL MAGIC tracked the leaders near the inside racing into the turn but lacked the needed closing response. PRINCESS OF POWER settled off the inside early, was caught five wide racing through the turn and offered no rally.
