### Footnotes

MR. ALANZO, reserved outside foes in the second flight in the opening stages, steadily drew into striking distance racing three deep on the bend, angled four wide in upper stretch while being prompted to challenge, then made solid progress to the end to edge the pacesetter on the wire under firm encouragement. GREELEY'S FORTUNE angled inwards to prompt the pace outside a rival racing into the bend, forced the issue into upper stretch, edged forward to a clear advantage between calls in late stages but couldn't quite contain the winner. WINDY CITY LEAL tracked off the second flight three deep between foes racing to the bend, shifted out five wide in upper stretch and made some mild progress to close the gap on the top pair and earn a share. SHARP ROMA broke outwards bumping COELLA, was righted quickly to make steady progress along the rail racing into the bend, dued for command into upper stretch and weakened in the last furlong. LET'S POP THE CORK held up just off the first flight in the opening stages, shifted out to race four wide on the bend while making some effort to challenge after a half but had no final response. JO ALLEN'S KITTEN angled inwards gaining terms with a rival on the lead, disputed the pace between foes racing into the bend and gave way nearing midstretch. JADE MAN, bumped at the start, angled to the inside in the

opening quarter, shifted out to split foes nearing the furlong marker and displayed some belated interest. FEAR NOR FAVOR shied from rivals at the start, shifted outside foes while being urged to gain contention, raced four wide on the bend into upper stretch and lacked the needed late response. GOLD DE LAC shifted off the inside tracking the leaders from between foes racing to upper stretch but couldn't produce the needed closing bid. BARANIT broke outwards, bumped SHARP ROMA, was righted to track the leaders along the inside but retreated from contention early. COELLA, bumped at the start, recovered to briefly track off the second flight near the inside racing to the turn but steadily faded from contention. MR. QUINN broke outwards bumping JADE MAN, raced wide throughout and proved no factor.
