FOR TWO YEAR OLD COLTS AND GELDINGS. Nominations close Wednesday, October 29, 2011 with no fee. A supplementary nomination may be made at time of entry for \$1,500 which includes entry and starting fees. Original nominees to pay \$1,000 to pass the entry box. Original nominees that start will receive a \$750 rebate. \$60,000 Added, of which 60 percent of all monies to the owner of the winner, 20 percent to second, 11 percent to third, 6 percent to fourth and 3 percent to fifth. Weight 122 lbs. Winners of \$50,000 at a mile or over on the turf to carry 2 lbs. additional. Non-winners of \$35,000 at a mile or over on the turf allowed 2 lbs., non-winners of \$25,000 at a mile or over allowed 4 lbs.; of \$25,000 at any distance, 6 lbs. (Maiden, claiming or starter races not considered) High weights will be preferred, except different owners have equal draw according to weights and second parts of same owner entry receive no consideration over single entries. In the event of an oversubscribed field, low weighted horses preference will be determined by highest career earnings. Nominations closed Wednesday, October 19, 2011 with 28. (Rail at 10 feet).

Footnotes

NO SPIN was settled three deep racing well off the second flight racing to the backstretch, responded when prompted to circle foes with a sharp, four wide advance racing through the far turn to wrest a clear advantage nearing upper stretch and held sway to the end under firm right handed prompting. SCATTER A STAR, reserved along the inside tracking off the second flight in the opening half, shifted outside foes nearing upper stretch while being roused to advance four deep racing into upper stretch, couldn't gain terms with the winner but held grudgingly for place honors. SOUTHERN PARKWAY, reserved along the rail in the last flight racing to the backstretch, shifted out on the far turn splitting foes nearing upper stretch, angled out five wide racing through upper stretch while making steady progress and was just outfinished for place honors. DEVIL IN DISGUISE, held up off the second flight between foes in the opening half, shifted out four wide entering the far turn while being urged to advance, was fanned six wide racing into upper stretch but had no final kick. THREEFIFTYSEVENMAG, firmly rated just off the leaders along the inside racing to the backstretch, came around some tiring foes on the second bend but couldn't produce the needed closing response. LET'S GET CRACKIN, caught four wide racing into the first turn while prompted to secure a contending position, continued outside a rival in the second flight racing to the far turn, moved to challenge three deep between foes nearing upper stretch but came up empty in the drive. VILLE, forwardly placed stalking the pacesetter racing to the backstretch, was urged to challenge between foes racing into the far turn

but emptied out after six furlongs. STRONGEST LINK was settled into stride off the inside in early stages but never gained contention. WINNER'S SPIRIT, urged to secure the lead along the inside racing into the first turn, set the pace on a clear margin into the second bend and gave way abruptly after five furlongs. ARTIE'S LOVE, urged between foes to secure a forward placing racing into the first turn, was spent after a half.
